1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE SUBSTANCE / PREPARATION AND OF THE COMPANY / UNDERTAKING

Product name: EDILUBE GREASE

Use / description of product: Food safe grease.

2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Contains: Synthetic hydrocarbon thickened with aluminium complex soap; EP, anti-wear, anti-oxidant, corrosion inhibitor, friction reducing and polymer additives.

3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: No significant hazard.

Other hazards: This product is not classified as hazardous under current legislation.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: Unlikely to cause harm on brief or occasional contact; repeated and prolonged contact may lead to skin disorders.

Eye contact: May cause temporary discomfort.

Ingestion: Nausea and stomach pain may occur. There may be vomiting and diarrhoea.

Inhalation: Low volatility makes inhalation unlikely at ambient temperatures.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

Skin contact: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

Eye contact: Rinse with water for 10 minutes and seek medical advice if irritation persists.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. If conscious, give 1 pint of water to drink immediately. Seek medical attention.

Inhalation: If affected, remove to fresh air. Seek medical attention.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing media: Carbon dioxide. Dry chemical powder. Alcohol or polymer foam.

Exposure hazards: Toxic or irritating fumes may be released at elevated temperatures. Products of combustion: carbon, oxides of carbon, sulphur and fluorine.

Protection of fire-fighters: Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions: Eliminate all sources of ignition. Wear appropriate protective clothing.

Environmental precautions: Contain the spillage using bunding. Do not discharge into drains or rivers.

Clean-up procedures: Spillage of this material presents a slip hazard. Absorb into dry earth or sand. Scrub

contaminated surfaces with detergent solution. Retain washings as contaminated waste and transfer to sealed, labelled container for safe disposal.

Storage conditions: Store between 0 and 35 Deg.C. Keep container tightly closed.
